Brand et Fils labels are all calligrams authored by Guillaume Apollinaire, a French poet from the early 20th century. Philippe and Charles were inspired by Apollinaire's poem 'Nuit Rhénane' in which Apollinaire characterizes the Alsatian summer with the image of "fairies with green hair." They switched to these labels when the domaine switched to biodynamic/natural winemaking, to indicate to customers the change in the taste of the wines.

region: Ergersheim, Alsace, France

varietal: Muscat, 50 yr old vines, Les coteaux du

Kefferberg

farming: organic/biodynamic

soils: clay, limestone

vinification: indigenous yeasts, 6 months in Foudre, no fining or filtering, no added sulphites

abv: 12%,

residual sugar: <3 g/l cellar: 5-6 years



tasty notes

This white wine will surprise you with its aromatic power and freshness! It's a bone dry, elegant, fresh and crisp Muscat with floral notes, milky lychees, camomile, subtle spice and a touch of bitterness on the finish. Lot's of balanced acidity, lovely texture and great depth makes it a crazy-fun wine to pair with food but as with all the other Brand et Fils wines, it's beautiful all on its own.
