## spec & tech

**Region:** VdF, Languedoc-Roussillon, France  
**Varietals:** Blanc de Noir (Mourvèdre and Lledonner Pellut) and Blanc de Blanc (Carignan Gris and Blanc, Macabeu).  
**Vine Age:** gris & white Carignan: 80 yrs, Macabeu: 80+ yrs, Lledoner Pellut: 30 yrs, Mourvèdre: 20 yrs  
**Farming:** organic, manual harvest  
**Soils:** Millas granite with biotite  
**Vinification:** indigenous yeasts, minimal sulfites, aged for 12 months in used barrels.



## tasty notes

White slightly tinged with pink, with notes of lilac, small red fruits and citrus. A fresh and slender mouth, a fine spicy grip, with minerality and tension.
