spec & tech

Region: Côtes du Roussillon Villages Caramany, Languedoc-Roussillon, France

Varietals: Grenache (80%) and Carignan (20%)

Vines: Grenache - 50 yrs, Carignan - 70 yrs

Farming: organic, manual harvest

Soils: Millas granite with biotite

Vinification: grapes blended after a short maceration in tank, indigenous yeasts, minimal sulfites, 12 months in old barrels.



tasty notes

Their vineyards are located in the Pyrenees which boasts some of the highest elevation vineyards in France. Fresh red fruits, some black pepper, with lovely complexity and seductiveness. A wine that invites you to drink it with relish; powerful with a nice balance between acidity and tannins.
