spec & tech

Region: Savennières, Anjou, Loire, France

Varietal: 100% Chenin Blanc

Soil: yellow sandstone and slate

Farming: organic, Guyot double, harvested by hand in successive sorting

Vinification: slow direct pressing, natural fermentations in small tanks for more than 20 months, no added sulphur, vegan

ABV: 13%

Cellaring: 8-10 years

What a dream! Beautiful nose of yellow and white fruits with floral and dry herb notes. The palate is full, rich and complex with a saline finish, and its concentration reveals a beautiful structure. Great balance and length. Fabulous!
